# **Business and Private Trips**

A Business Trip is when a resource utilizes an asset during working hours. A Private Trip is when a resource uses an asset for personal use such as during a break, lunch time, and travel time to and from work.

#### **Overview:**

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• Business and Private Trip settings are visible from the Trip Replay screen.

### Steps:

- 1. Tap the Magnify Glass icon from the tracking screen
- 2. Tap the Assets tab below the search bar on the left
- 3. Select your asset by tapping the corresponding description from the list below
- 4. You will then be returned to the tracking screen
- 5. Tap the **asset** at the center of the map
- 6. Tap the **blue Trip Replay button** at the bottom right of the screen



- Once you have selected Trip Replay, the Trip Replay screen displays the trips for the current day. Just as a reminder, a **Trip** is defined as Ignition On to Ignition Off.
- You may select a start and end date from the calendar dropdown at the top of the screen, or tap the downward arrow next to the end date to pick from the following selections: today, yesterday, last week, or last month.
- The app will then populate a list of trips for the selected date range sorted chronologically by date beginning with the oldest at the top.

## Steps:

- 1. Tap the Start Date and/or End Date
- 2. Select the date and tap Ok



- If a Resource forgets to change their trip to Private when they are using an Asset for personal use, an Administrator can make the changes on their behalf from the desktop or web application.
- A trip can be changed from Business to Private from the Trip Replay screen.

Steps: Changing a Trip from Business to Private

- 1. Tap the downward arrow next to Business within the trip you would like to change
- 2. From the list, select Private



- When a trip is set to Private, the location information is hidden.
- The location information will not be uploaded to the FC Web or Desktop applications.
- The Start and End times of the trip will be visible.
- The Administrator can change the trip from Business to Private or vise-versa at anytime.



FC captures all relevant sensor readings for Assets which allows you to monitor your fleet. This information is available via Rules as well as Reports. Some examples of Asset Sensors include: Rapid Acceleration and Harsh Cornering.

- This screen is VIEW ONLY, and changes to sensors can only be made from the FC Web or Desktop application.
- The **Updated at** section will display the date and time of when the sensors were last updated.
